

Riverside Park Dog Run Rules

Dog Run Hours: Dawn to Dusk - Dogs Only

This is a Use-At-Your-Own-Risk Dog Run*

Users of the Dog Run must abide by the following Rules:

1. All dogs must be leashed upon entering and leaving the Dog Run. All spike, pinch, and choke collars must be removed when entering the Dog Run.
2. No aggressive dogs... First sign of aggression, dog must be removed. If you suspect your dog may become aggressive, use a muzzle. Dogs involved in a fight must leave the Dog Run until all parties calm down.
3. No one under the age of 12 will be allowed into the Dog Run. Anyone between the age of 13 to 18 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
4. 2 dog maximum per person; accompany your dog in the Dog Run at all times; no puppies under the age of 4 months.
5. All dogs must be licensed and be up-to-date on vaccinations, all tags must be visible per state law; be healthy (have no contagious conditions or diseases) and be parasite free (both internally and externally).
6. No dogs in heat allowed in the Dog Run; closely monitor un-neutered males.
7. No smoking allowed in the Dog Run.
8.
 - a) No toys or frisbees allowed (to help avoid fights)
 - b) You **MUST** clean up after your dog (remove canine fecal matter)
 - c) Owner must provide fresh water for dog;
 - d) Discourage barking, especially during early morning and late evening hours.

***Users of the Dog Run do so at their own risk.** In consideration of the being able to use the Dog Run, the User agrees that neither the Town of Raymond nor the Parks and Recreation Department shall be liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog or User in Riverside Park. As the Dog Run is dedicated to user groups, the maintenance and enforcement of rules in the Dog Run are up to the users.

Users are legally and financially responsible for their dog's behavior.
